2012 Summer Shakespeare Festival Features *Twelfth Night*

Outdoor theatre festival features fun for the whole family

West Hartford, CT (December 7, 2011): Capital Classics Theatre Company enters into its 22nd anniversary season with the staging of *Twelfth Night; or, What You Will*, as part of central Connecticut's longest-running Shakespeare festival, for three weekends: July 26 through August 12, 2012.

Performances will be held on Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays at 7:30 PM and Sundays at 5:30 PM. Capital Classics has built a reputation for making Shakespeare accessible to the thousands of fans that turn out each summer with their family and friends—and picnic baskets—to enjoy outdoor “Shakespeare under the stars” on the grounds of Saint Joseph College, West Hartford, Connecticut.
